Substitution of Initial Sound

Consider using the following activities at home with your child:

★ We can change the first sound in a word to make a new word. Tell your child: "Say my, change /m/ to /b/ and the word is?" and your child would say: " by".

- Other words to try:
 - By, change /b/ to /t/ and the word is \rightarrow tie
 - *Tie*, change /t/ to /l/ and the word is \rightarrow lie

 \star Give your child a word with a beginning blend and have them repeat it back. Then, change the first sound to a new sound and see if they can tell you the new word.

- $\circ~$ Say trick \rightarrow change /t/ to /b/ and the word is? \rightarrow brick
- \circ Say flow \rightarrow change /f/ to /s/ and the word is? \rightarrow slow
- \circ Say clock \rightarrow change /c/ to /f/ and the word is? \rightarrow flock
